New Flyer of America was selected in a competitive RFP process in 2018 for a five-year contract during which 72 new forty-foot diesel buses would be purchased by the City. The City has thus far spent \$12,757,763 for 27 of those buses in 2019 and 2020. The City has also spent \$339,000 on parts for New Flyer buses since 2016. The parts purchases are considered non-competitively selected because no competitive process was used to select them as a vendor, but each bus manufacturer requires their own proprietary parts, and so when we competitively select the bus manufacturer, we end up having to purchase parts from them as well.
