

16 billion disposable coffee cups are used each year. These are coated with plastic to laminate the inside and use plastic lids.




Currently, the average American discards about 80 pounds of clothing each year, 85 percent of which ends up in landfills (15% recycled).

Cars and light trucks emitted 1.1 billion metric tons CO<sub>2</sub>e or 17% of the 2017 total U.S. greenhouse gas emissions

**FOSSIL FUELS** A natural fuel, like coal, formed in the geological past from the remains of living organisms



**COMBUSTIBLES FÓSILES** Un combustible natural, como el carbón, formado en el pasado geológico a partir de los restos de organismos vivos.
