- · Show accessible route to the Community Room.
- Study fin wall depth by loading area to be deep enough to screen view from East Washington Avenue.
- Study soffit material to deal with uplighting.
- Look at what materials crawl up from base of main structure; masonry on base?
- Provide bike parking in area near the seating wall and firm up the total number of bike parking stalls being provided.
- Look at the use of large trees and look at columnar trees along the street is concern with spacing.
- There is a limit on the number of species of trees given the quantity; look at matching trees that look the same but are different for consistency.
- · Show how you plan to deal with soils.
