Discussion of 800 block of State Street and Pedestrian usage--by City Engineering staff, Chris Petykowski and Planning staff, Warren Hansen.

Street Vending Coordinator for the City of Madison, Warren Hansen, and City Engineer, Chris Petykowski, went over the Vendor's on State Street. Hansen supplied the commission with a handout, detailing which food cart trucks were stationed where during the construction, explaining the decisions are sometimes based on whether or not the vendor needs electrical outputs. Bennett expressed concern with the angle of some of the vendors food carts blocking off Lake Street to cyclists and pedestrians. Hansen believed when the construction is complete, this problem will be resolved. However, he did agree to have both himself and the street vending monitor remind the vendors to keep their carts at ninety degree angles.
