 48668 2018 Room Tax Commission Budget Decisions and Review of Revenues and Expenditures

The members of the Room Tax Commission unanimously adopted a budget for 2018, as amended.

The 2018 proposed budget was amended to increase funding for Fairs, Festivals and Summer Concerts by \$5,000. This amendment was adopted on a 4 to 2 vote (Ziarnik and Krieg voting no).

The adopted 2018 budget reflects a 10% room tax rate. The Room Tax Commission will convene to amend the 2018 budget if a room tax rate change is not adopted by the Common Council.

2. 48667 Transfer of 2017 Room Tax Funding from Monona Terrace Bike Path Project to Olin Terrace Repairs Project

The members of the Room Tax Commission took action on Legislative File No. 48493.

3. 48493 Amending the 2017 Adopted Capital Budget for the Monona Terrace to authorize use of up to \$65,000 from the Monona Terrace Bike Path Project to fund Tile and Other Repairs on the Olin Terrace.

A motion was made by Clear, seconded by Krieg, to Return to Lead with the Recommendation for Approval to the FINANCE COMMITTEE and should be returned by 9/11/2017. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
