\$15,000 for Fairs/Festivals/Summer Concerts (instead of \$17,500)

\$22,500 for Downtown Temporary Art Installations (instead of \$30,000)

7. Art in Public Places

Staff will work with Public Art Chair Bethany Jurewicz to finalize the application, guidelines, and promote the opportunity.

Update Leopold Public Art Project - Several years ago MAC funded an AIPP project to create a gateway project near Leopold School. Artist Sonia Valle designed the piece and collaborated with Artist Michael Burns to fabricate it. With the generous support of City Engineering we anticipate that it will be installed at some point this week. I will send you photos and a link to the media release when it is in

Update on Shift - Engineering is moving forward with installing the infrastructure. The piece itself is fabricated. Still hoping it can be installed this summer. It continues to move along slowly.

Update Teresa Terrace - Staff is again meeting with Anwar Floyd-Pruitt this week to determine how we can help him move forward with a community engagement strategy in spite of COVID-19. He received MAC funding (as well as \$500 for a public art mentor) to create a screen design for Theresa Terrace Community Center, currently occupied by Madison Youth Company.
