Mayor's Directive on a Citywide Fiber Network

Kronberger presented the Mayor's directive regarding development of a plan to provide a city-wide fiber network. The resulting fiber network should cover the entire city and include options to provide free or low-cost services to economically challenged households. Enis Ragland added the committee and IT staff are being asked to investigate possible models and to develop an implementation plan. Orton and Evans expressed interest in forming a workgroup.

In light of this new direction, the committee is also being asked to discuss and determine whether the city should move forward with the current LTE wireless Digital Divide pilot project. After discussion about the fiber network and the timeline for implementation of such a project, the committee agreed to move forward with the RFP process for the DD pilot project.
