Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and David P. Schmiedicke, the Director's initial year's salary will be based on an annualized rate of \$154,000, effective July 31, 2016, and will be adjusted by the base rate increase provided to employees in CG 21 in the last pay period of June 2016. The Finance Department's 2016 operating budget includes sufficient funding. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.
