Title

Declaring the City of Madison's intention to exercise its police powers establishing the Garfield Street Utility Assessment District - 2015. (13th AD)

Body

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

- That the Common Council of the city of Madison hereby establishes an assessment district known as the Garfield Street Utility Assessment District - 2015 to serve Garfield Street from Madison Street to Monroe Street; all in accordance with Section 66.0701 (formerly Section 66.62) of the Wisconsin State Statutes and Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
- That the contemplated purpose of this assessment district is to replace existing sanitary sewer laterals and to connect private storm sewer laterals.
- That the benefited properties shall have the opportunity to pay the special assessments which may be levied as a result of this assessment district in eight (8) annual installments, subject to the current interest rate in effect at the time of establishment of the special assessment.
- That the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare a report consisting of preliminary or final plans and specifications; an estimate of the entire cost of the proposed work or improvements within the assessment district; a schedule of proposed assessments, constituting an exercise of police power of the City of Madison; and a statement that the property against which the assessments are proposed is benefited.
- That upon completion of this aforesaid report, the City Engineer shall proceed in accordance with Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
