In the adopted 2016 Capital Budget the Streets Division has budgeted \$385,325 for the replacement of facility grounds components at the various vehicle bay sites under the Streets Minor Building Improvements and Repairs program (MUNIS 11001). This program has sufficient funding for the proposed work in this resolution. Funding is provided by GO borrowing.
