Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget Engineering - Ped/Bike has budgeted \$680,000 for various projects within the Bikeways Program (MUNIS 10138). This minor project for the East Johnson Street Path is established with sufficient budget authority for the proposed demolition in this resolution (MUNIS 10461). Funding is provided by GO borrowing.
