Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget the Stormwater Utility budgeted \$1.06 million for the TMDL compliance program (MUNIS 10343) in order to manage the discharges to the Rock River Watershed. The minor project for the Starkweather Alum Treatment System (MUNIS 10368) is established with sufficient budget authority for the proposed work in this resolution. Funding is provided by GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution approves the contract for the professional services needed for the Starkweather Creek project at an estimated cost of \$117,000.
