Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget Engineering - Facilities Management has budgeted \$1.05 million for the Park Facilities Improvement program (MUNIS 10564) which provides for enhancements to the City's Parks facilities. The minor project for the Esther Beach Restroom improvements are budgeted within this program with sufficient budget authority for the work specified in this contract. Funding is provided by GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution awards the contract at an estimated cost of \$463,200.
