Fiscal Note

The 2017 capital budget includes \$3,175,000 (\$2,150,000 reauthorized and \$1,025,000 new funding) for the Library Maintenance Support Center project (MUNIS 10001) funded by GO Borrowing. The bid referenced in the proposed resolution is for the remodeling of the Maintenance Support Center building. The estimated cost is \$2,540,000 and is available in account 10001-50-140.
