In the adopted 2017 capital budget Engineering-Facilities Management has budgeted \$23,000,000 for the renovation of the Madison Municipal Building (MMB) (MUNIS 10129). The proposed resolution approves plan documents and authorizes the bid process for the project. The estimated cost is \$22,500,000 to be funded by GO Borrowing.

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public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer & Civil Rights Director may delay the due date for the SBE documents up to one working day following receipt of the bids.
