Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and Mahanth S. Joishy, the Fleet Service Superindent's initial year's salary will be based on a total annualized rate of \$123,983 effective July 11th, 2017. The Fleet Service's 2017 operating budget includes sufficient funding for the costs. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.
