Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and Harper Donahue, IV, the Human Resources Director's salary will be based on a total annualized rate of \$137,000 effective January 17, 2018. The Human Resources Director position is approved and funded in the 2018 Adopted Operating Budget. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.

WHEREAS, Mayor Soglin has appointed Harper Donahue IV to the position of Human Resources Director and has recommended to the Common Council that his appointment be confirmed; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached an accord on the terms and conditions of an Employment Agreement between the City and Mr. Donahue.

NOW THEREFORE, be resolved that Mr. Donahue's appointment to the position of Human Resources Director is hereby confirmed, and the Mayor and the City Clerk's office are authorized to execute an Employment Agreement between the City and Mr. Donahue.
