Funds for this sole source are from the 2024 Operating Budget Finance Committee Amendment 17-SUB, which was intended to provide Public Health \$68,000 to distribute to agencies that would perform support activities to apartments that are under and/or at risk of public nuisance declarations. Public Health Resolution 83009 was presented in the consent agenda at the April 16, 2024, city council meeting. The resolution seeks to name Each One Teach One, Just Dane, 4-C's and Operation Fresh Start as recipients of the \$68,000.

Over the past year, the city of Madison has needed to declare nuisance abatement proceedings on several apartment complexes, including the Meadowlands and Harmony due to gun violence and other violent crimes. It has created a growing challenge for the tenants that continue to suffer with very little access to resources. Public Health Madison Dane County's Violence Intervention has worked to support these communities. This work has been strengthened by the partnerships with key community agencies partners.

It is critical that these partners that are embedded in the community, familiar with the challenges of residences through their current efforts, be selected to receive funds to support their work. They are uniquely positioned both through their experience and existing relationships to support the needs of these communities.

In this request, we are seeking to select Each One Teach One (EOTO) to receive \$28,125 to provide onsite apartments services including, providing wrap around support for tenants, provide liaison support between tenants and property owners, and peer support for youth. EOTO has been an on-going partner in this work and has developed the important connections and trust with these communities that make them an essential partner for this work. Given this, and their robust experiencing implementing community-based programs that concentrate on using violence prevention, we think it is critical that be contracted with the funds to support their work. In addition to the current time constraints in disseminating funds.
