**Metro Transit – Proposed August Service Adjustments

On Wednesday, April 10, Metro Transit and the City of Madison Transit and Parking Commission will hold a public hearing at 6 PM to discuss service changes proposed to go into effect in August.

Proposed service changes include the creation of a new Route 31 to the Owl Creek neighborhood. Possible adjustments to Routes 1, 2, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 18, 19, 25, 28, 31, 33, 34, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 47, 52, 56, 57, 59, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 74 are also being considered.

Adjustments are expected to affect riders in the Arbor Hills and Belmar neighborhoods as well as the East Transfer Point, Sheboygan Ave., and Allied Dr. areas. Additional routes and affected areas may be included at the public hearing.

Interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing to give feedback. Consideration will be given to views and comments expressed at the public hearing as well as to all written comments received.
