Dear ALRC Members:

CNI's Alcohol Issues Committee does not object to licenses for the Majestic (agenda item 2) and Capitol Center Foods (agenda item 16).

Bullfeathers (agenda item 13): We are opposed to the 21+ license given the history of problems with this license. We support rigorous disciplinary action to protect the public health and safety. CNI is troubled by the high density of alcohol licenses and capacity of establishments in the downtown that focus on alcohol sales.

Opus Lounge (agenda Item 15): We are not opposed to this license. As you know, the total licensed capacity of King Street exceeds the current sidewalk capacity. We anticipate a continuing problem with pedestrian traffic in the street, not as a result of any single licensed establishment but as a result of alcohol outlet density on King Street. Both the ALRC and Madison Police should monitor the situation and consider implementing one of the many suggestions offered in the past to remedy the situation.
