Dear Traffic Engineering:

Thank you for presenting to the Disability Rights Commission (DRC) about pedestrian safety on March 26, 2026. As you are aware, deadly driver speeds on Madison's streets continue to escalate due to driver apathy and lawlessness.

The Disability Rights Commission provides recommendations related to issues that may affect people with disabilities and their families. Pedestrian safety measures are essential for people with disabilities to access transportation and their communities. We believe the following recommendations will support existing efforts to make the public right-of-way safer for people with disabilities and other communities in Madison.

Recommendations:

1. Add: No Right on Red
2. Work with County, State and Federal agencies to lower speeds on all streets within the City of Madison
