Proposed Timeline:

Fall 2020 – UW student focus groups

Winter 2020 – Current and potential food cart operator's focus group

Spring 2021 – Staff planning, research and recommendations

Summer 2021 – present results and recommendations to VOC and other city committees or agencies

Fall/Winter 2021 - prepare changes to introduce to the Common Council and City Committees

Early Spring 2022 – make any infrastructure changes recommended to State St. Mall

Spring 2022 – License vendors for the new Late Night Vending program
