

The City of Madison is proposing to improve South Point Road from Harvest Moon Lane to Mineral Point Road. This project involves special assessments to owners of property along the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will be making a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property on the project.

Scope of Work

This project includes the construction of a divided roadway with bike lanes and a storm sewer system. Trees will be need removed, from within the right-of-way, to facilitate the roadway construction. If the project is approved, construction will start in early 2011 and be completed by mid-June, 2011.

Street Improvements

The proposed street improvements include the construction of concrete curb and gutter, concrete drive aprons and an asphalt pavement. The finished street will be a boulevard with one thirteen (13) foot travel lane, a bike lane and a buffer separating the bike lane from the travel lane, in each direction.

Sidewalk will be installed on the west side of the street, near Mineral Point Road.

Drive Aprons

The drive apron, the area between the sidewalk and curb, will be constructed with concrete. The aprons are proposed to be the same width as the driveway, at the property line, and will be four feet wider at the curb. Prior to construction, residential property owners will receive a copy of a Residential Driveway Opening Request form which allows them change the size of the proposed apron, provided that is complies with the Madison General Ordinances. Commercial driveways will be reconstructed in accordance with the approved parking lot plan on file with the City.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

It is anticipated that up to three trees will need to be removed as part of the construction process.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on landscape features in the right-of-way. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that the entire right-of-way, will be disturbed. Therefore, any plantings or special landscaping or decorative features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed from the right-of-way prior to the start of construction.

Storm Sewer

Storm sewer main, leads, and inlets will be installed or replaced as part of this project. This work is not assessed to property owners. Elia Acosta is the storm sewer designer for this project; you may contact her at 266-4096 or eacosta@cityofmadison.com.

Assessments

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an estimate of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. When the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

The City and the property owners adjoining the project will share the cost of the street improvements. The property owner is responsible for the cost of the sidewalk, curb and gutter, drive aprons and a cost equal to four (4) feet of the roadway. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the assessable items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner.
