6. Syene Road Assessment District

This project will disturb over one acre of land, which will require a WRAPP from the Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. **(Jim Wolfe, City Engineering)**

7. Sycamore Avenue Assessment District

This project will disturb over one acre of land, which will require a WRAPP from the Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. **(Eric Dundee, City Engineering)**

8. Mendota Street Assessment District

This project will disturb over one acre of land, which will require a WRAPP from the Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. **(Eric Dundee, City Engineering)**

9. Thorp Street Assessment District

This project will disturb over 4,000 square feet, which will require an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering, but will not require a permit from the DNR since disturbance is less than one acre. **(Eric Dundee, City Engineering)**
