# RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

13. <u>10093</u> Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Hiestand Park Shelter Installation, Contract No. 6226. (3rd AD)

Estimated cost of this project is \$81,300. The neighborhood plan lists a shelter/shade canopy as another priority in the development of the Hiestand Park. The Parks Department will be working with the neighborhood to find a suitable vendor to supply the materials to construct an open air shelter by a local contractor on a concrete pad including electrical service and an opportunity for a drinking fountain.

14. Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Ravine Street Arch Culvert Rehab, Contract No. 6172. (10th & 11th ADs)

Estimated cost of this project is \$80,000. The Ravine Street Arch Culvert is located under the Southwest Bike Path and is in need of rehabilitation. The project will consist of spray lining the arch with shotcrete, installing a new reinforced concrete floor, and the removal and replacement of the existing upstream and downstream culvert gates.
