Entertainment and Security Information

Type of live entertainment to be offered: Dining-focused live performances such as DJs or musicians providing background/ambient music during scheduled dinner service hours. Entertainment is designed to complement the dining experience and is not nightclub-style.

Number of security personnel and how they will be utilized: _____
No dedicated security personnel. Management and trained staff will monitor guest behavior and ensure compliance with alcohol laws and house policies.

Description of clothing to identify security personnel: _____
Not applicable. Managers on duty will be clearly identifiable in professional attire.

Plan to handle control and clearance of the parking lot during hours of operation and at closing time:
The premises operates as a restaurant. Staff will monitor guest flow at closing and ensure orderly departure. No toting will be permitted.

How will the entrance line be managed and controlled: _____
There are no general admission lines. Seating is primarily reservation-based. A host will manage guest check-in and ensure orderly entry.

Plan for unruly patrons, intoxicated patrons, and physical disturbances: _____
Staff are trained in responsible beverage service. Intoxicated guests will not be served. Management will intervene immediately in any disturbance and may require guests to leave. Law enforcement will be contacted if necessary.

Underage drinking and fake ID plan: _____
All staff are trained to check valid government-issued photo identification for every guest. Alcohol will not be served to underage patrons. Fake IDs will be confiscated when appropriate and law enforcement notified if required.

Plan to control and supervise patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age: _____
If permitted for designated 18+ performances, underage patrons will only be allowed in the entertainment/dining area during scheduled performance times and will not be permitted to linger in bar-only areas. Staff will monitor compliance at all times.

How will orderly appearance and operation of the premises be maintained in regard to litter and noise:
Staff will continuously monitor cleanliness inside and outside the premises. Trash will be regularly removed. Music levels will remain appropriate for a dining environment. Doors and windows will remain closed during dinner service and during music performance.

Additional Required Items for Visual and Performing Arts License (18+)

1. I understand all patrons must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to enter and remain on the premise.

2. Patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) may be allowed on the premise only for the purpose of live entertainment. Such shows must be designated as eighteen (18) and up shows and the entertainment must begin and end at a specified time. Patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) shall not be on the premise more than thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled live entertainment and must be off the premise within thirty (30) minutes of the live entertainment concluding.

Plan to ensure compliance with time requirements for patrons under the age of twenty-one (21):

Eighteen (18) and up performances will occur during clearly defined dinner service hours. Patrons under 21 will be admitted within thirty (30) minutes before the performance and must leave within thirty (30) minutes after it concludes. Host staff and management will monitor arrival and departure times to ensure compliance in a controlled dining environment.

3. Patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) may only be on the portion of the licensed premise where the live entertainment is occurring with the exception of incidental use of the restroom facilities and procuring a non-alcoholic beverage from the barroom. Under no circumstances will underage patrons be allowed to linger in a barroom that is separate from the live entertainment portion of the premise.

Plan to limit patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) to appropriate areas:

Patrons under twenty-one (21) will remain within the designated dining and live entertainment area during the performance. They will not be permitted to occupy bar-only areas, except for incidental restroom use or to obtain a non-alcoholic beverage. Staff and management will monitor guest movement to ensure that underage patrons do not linger in restricted areas.

4. I understand written notification **must** be provided to the Captain of the police district in which the establishment is located at least five (5) days prior to **all** eighteen (18) and up live entertainment performances. The notification shall include a detailed description of the performance including start and end times.

5. I understand only one (1) eighteen (18) and up live entertainment event may be held per week.

6. I agree not to sell more than one alcoholic beverage to an eligible patron in a single transaction during eighteen (18) and up live entertainment events and shall prohibit a patron from carrying more than one alcoholic beverage from a bar or drink dispensing location during eighteen (18) and up live entertainment events.

7. I agree to comply with the identification requirements in Sec. 38.04(6), MGO, relating to conspicuously identifying patrons who are twenty-one (21) years of age and older.
