



PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the next few months, June through October 2008. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, June 18, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install buried fiber optic cable within the roadway limits at the following location:

1. Location of buried fiber is from the front of 5625 E. Buckeye Rd. east 230' then South along S. Thompson Dr. for 700' to the rear of 5642 Irongate Dr. The fiber cable and the new equipment will be placed in the ROW and will be directional bored.
2. Location of buried fiber is from the intersection of Raymond Rd. and McKenna Blvd. going north 1,270', placing a handhole then crossing McKenna Blvd to the east for 80' then continuing into a 10' public utility easement. The fiber cable will be directional bored and placed in the ROW for this distance.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5' lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
