

PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the next few months, July through October 2008. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, July 16, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install buried fiber optic cable within the roadway limits at the following location:

- 1. Beginning at the intersection of Monona Dr going east on Dean Av for 1,519' then crossing Dean Av to the north into easement.
- Beginning on Independence La 112 'west of the intersection with E.
 Washington Av head east then heading north on the Frontage Rd 350' to the
 intersection of the Frontage Rd and Columbus La and go 260' west on
 Columbus La.
- 3. Beginning on Mesta La 105' north of the intersection with Prairie Rose Rd head south then east on Prairie Rose Rd for 100' then north into utility easement.
- 4. Beginning at the corner of Mineral Point and Nautilis going north on Nautilis (west side) to Offshore going west on Offshore (south side) crossing Offshore going North on Quarterdeck (east side).
- 5. Beginning on Raymond Rd 467' from the intersection with Canterbury Rd head east to Canterbury Rd them south on Canterbury Rd for 1900' then west into utility easement.
- 6. Beginning on the north side of Commercial Av 347' west of Walsh Rd going east to Ziegler Rd. then north on Ziegler Rd for 70'.
- 7. Beginning at the intersection of Regent St and Lathrop St head north on the east side of Lathrop for 423'.

The fiber cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
