Dear ALRC members,

I am unable to join you at your May 30 meeting. I am writing about two district 2 establishments on your agenda:

Agenda Item 12 and 19 - The Edgewater

I ask that you retain the conditions as passed last fall. There has not been sufficient time to assess whether these conditions along with other efforts being made by Edgewater management (e.g. the band shell) will successfully address the significant noise problems that have been experienced by neighbors. I am hopeful...but there simply has not been enough time to assess since the outdoor music/event season just got underway.

Agenda Item 22 - Festival Foods

I request that the same conditions as those placed on Riley's and many other isthmus establishments be placed on Festival Foods. I have spoken to Mr. Kevin Schnell, Madison Store Director of Skogen's Festival Foods regarding these conditions and have shared them with him. Patty Prime, President of the Tenney Lapham Neighborhood Association; Lt Brian Chaney Austin and I have met with Mr Schnell in regard to individuals with alcohol dependency problems purchasing alcohol from Festival and causing disturbances in the neighborhood. Festival Foods has been a wonderful neighbor and much appreciated resource in the neighborhood. I understand Mr Schnell is supportive of these conditions.
