TO: Frazier Avenue Property Owners Adjacent to Street Resurfacing - 2011

You were previously sent information about a proposed project to resurface Frazier Avenue in 2011. Since then we have revisited this street and modified the scope of work. Frazier Avenue will not be resurfaced and defective curb and gutter will not be replaced. Instead the street will be milled and paved in two areas to repair some failed patches.

Waunona Way will still be resurfaced and the defective curb and gutter will be replaced. The limits of the Waunona Way project do extend onto part of Frazier Avenue. The affected properties on Frazier Avenue did receive the appropriate assessment notices.

You are being sent this letter to notify you of the Board of Public Works Meeting on January 19 to formally adopt this revision to the project scope. The meeting will be at 5:30 at the Madison Water Utility Building, conference room A/B, located at 119 East Olin Avenue.
