Petition for "Equal treatment for BMX riders in Madison Skatepark"

We, the undersigned, as residents of Madison and Wisconsin, support the use of BMX bicycles in the aforementioned skatepark. This petition is not a request for a new, separate skatepark designed specifically for BMX bicycles. It asks for equal treatment for BMX riders in an existing skatepark.

It is a common misconception that BMX bicycles in skateparks create a dangerous environment. BMX bicycles are equipped with brakes and are highly maneuverable, making them at least as safe as the skateboards and/or inline skates already permitted to use the skatepark.

Many cities around the country already recognize this by permitting BMX bicycles into publicly funded skateparks, where they coexist with other skatepark users. Countless private skateparks already demonstrate that any and all skatepark designs are compatible with BMX bicycles.

For all of the above reasons and more, we, the undersigned, recognize the need for equal treatment for BMX riders, that they may have a safe and legal area to enjoy their sport.

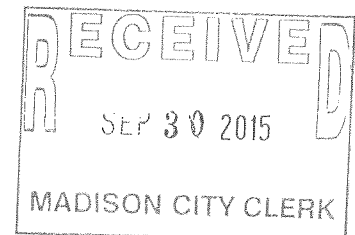

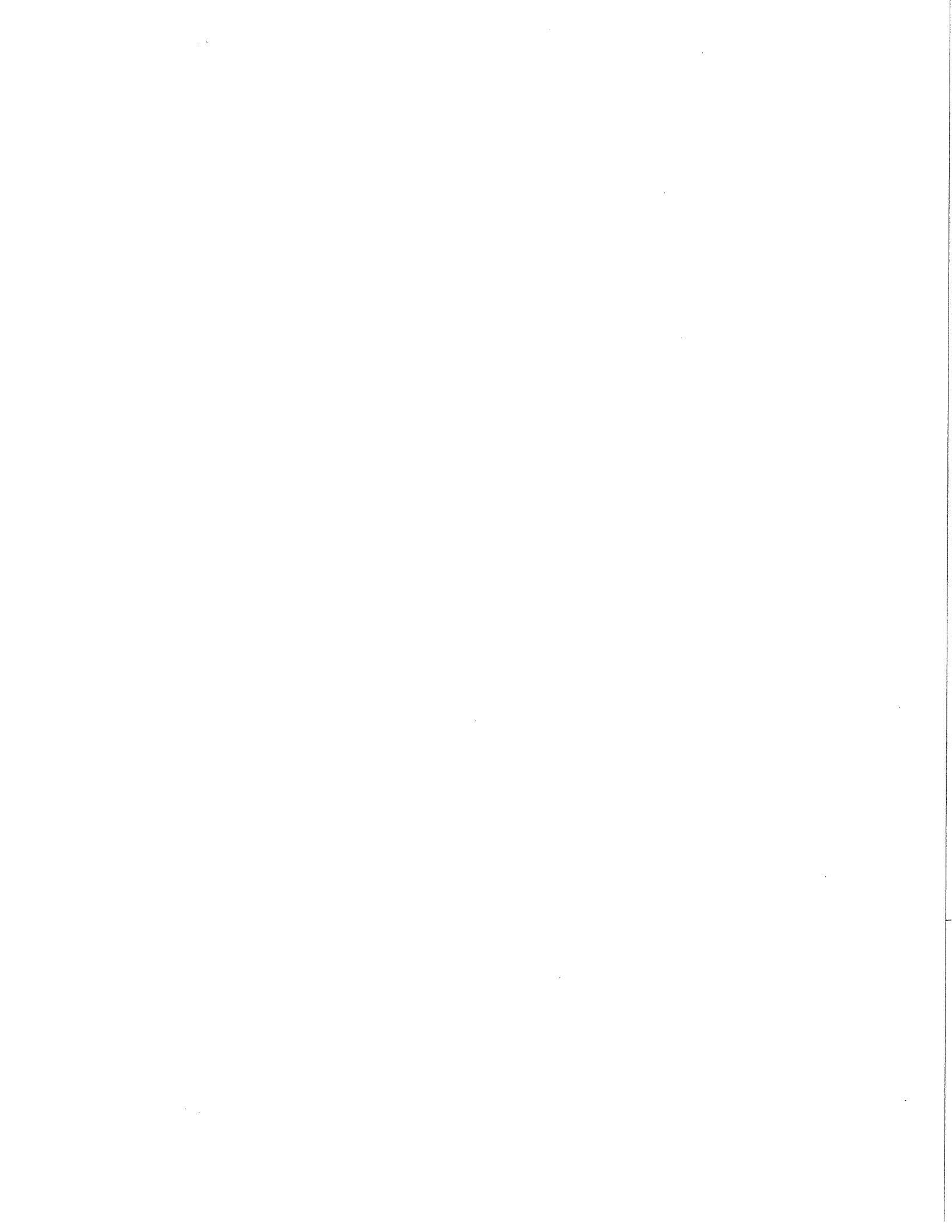

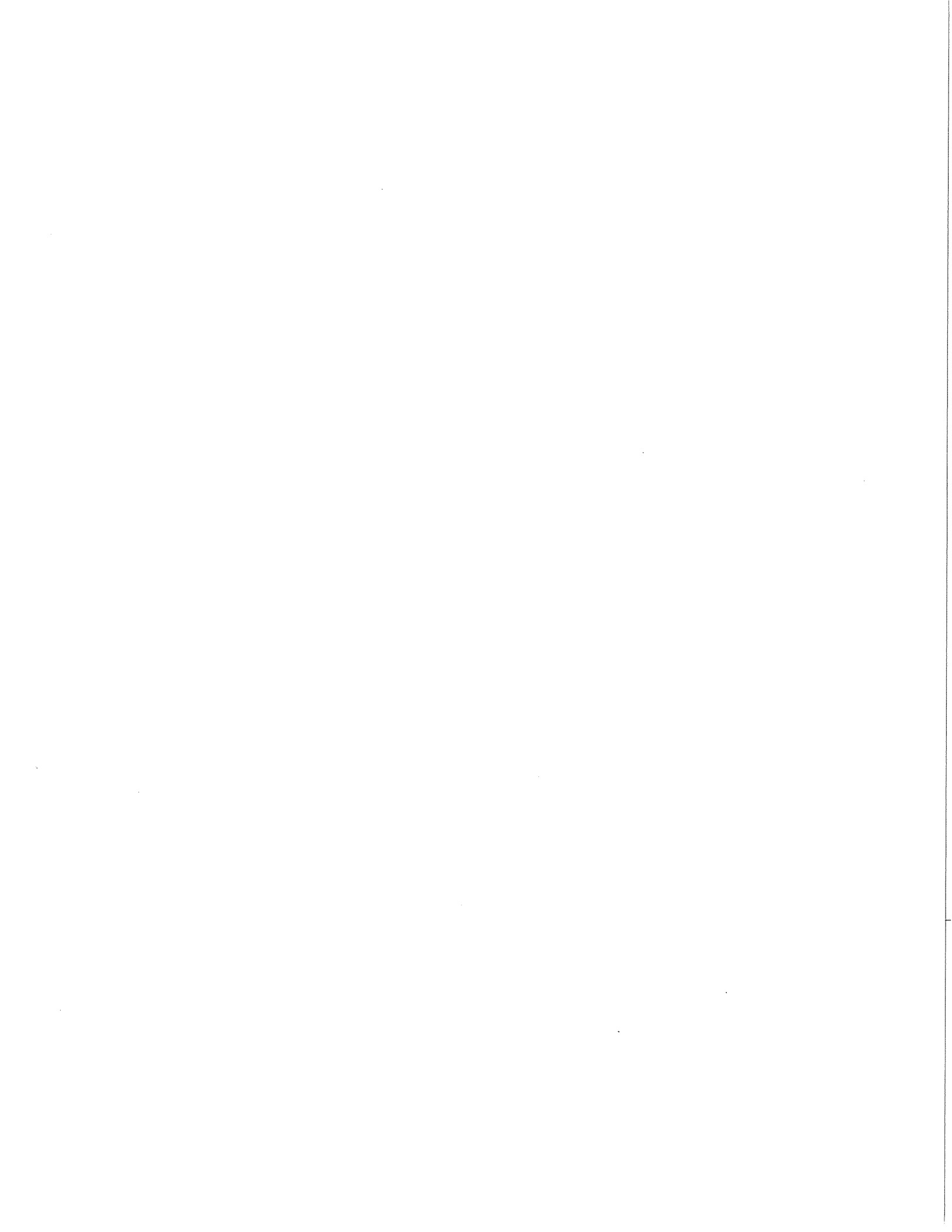

I live in the northwest U.S. now and in 15 minutes I will be at one of the many, many public skateparks here that allow bikes. Everyone on wheels coexists and is spatially aware of each other. It is possible, I live it. We all get over our pride and egos and we share because sometimes we all just want to go ride somewhere fun without worrying about having our hands zip-tied behind our backs, being bullied by cars, or being jumped by meth-heads. We are more worried about negligent parents who let their small children run around and lay in the park without a board or bike than whether we think someone of a different wheeled discipline deserves to be there or not. People here all grew up sharing these city built public spaces from a young age and therefore it is a non-issue. Don't let the grudges of a few older skaters rub off on the kids. Public skateparks are always inhabited and naturally ""policed"" by people who are serious about doing whatever activity they love, not by some sign on the wall. Everyone is there because of the signs on the walls throughout the city in the first place.

At the park I frequent, compromise is made and there is an unwritten code of respectful conduct. If it's ""go skate day"" I don't mind going to find a different place to ride for one day or I just enjoy the show. If there is a heavy crew of bikers there from out of town the skaters chill and watch. We don't need to prove a point over everything. If you are there all the time and you show respect, then it doesn't matter what you ride—you are a local. As a BMX-er, I have met and talked to so many cool people who skate there. Older skaters here bring their kids on BMX bikes and vice versa.

The skaters I talk to here understand what it feels like to be hated and told that you can't be somewhere. We laugh, we learn, and we share experiences, many of which are the same. We talk about times we were chased, ticketed, banned or found ourselves in sketchy or funny situations because we were trying to find a safe place to peacefully ride. Our stories are almost interchangeable. I tell people here that growing up in Madison I never had a public park to ride and after primarily riding street wherever I lived over the last 10 years that this is all still pretty new to me—not being chased, hated, ran off the road, handcuffed or screamed at. The streets are always going to be a war between our views of what the urban landscape should be used for and the views of many others. A park is a place for us to let it go, express ourselves and just have fun legally.

Ten years ago, I used to practically live at Library Mall because that was all we had as a gathering place...all of us. It was a place where you saw people doing all kinds of interesting things. As far as skateboarders and BMX-ers go, we all got along there when we were all "outlaws". What happened? We all used to share the private skatepark 4 Seasons just fine. They could have excluded bikes but they didn't. They took my money every winter. 4 Seasons was/is fine employing, supporting and allowing bikes. The money it made from bikers helped pay its rent. While the Madison park is long closed the Milwaukee branch still seems to be thriving on the cooperation of bikers and skaters to run, build and patronize the park. Nobody there cares about bikes being a supposed "safety hazard" to this day. Now "safety" and "damage" seem like convenient excuses for a few skaters to clear out public territory for their own personal use. They are understandably frustrated that it took the city of Madison 14 years to build a park of any kind, and they want exclusive rights to justify their struggles. They may have started the effort for themselves, but a lot has changed in the last 15 years as far as "action sports" goes. More people skate and bike than ever and just about every town—big or small—in the state I live in now has a free public park, open to everybody. And believe me IT WORKS JUST FINE. Living in 1999 is not a solution to the problem. Don't blame BMX-ers for the fact that your city is so late to the table in catering to the needs of its youth and that they are were long out-of-touch with something that West Coast culture has already accepted. And don't blame BMX-ers, many of whom have been in the game for 15+ years riding the exact same spots because a few old skaters in Madison still think Thrasher's "BMX Jihad" article from 2003 is a blueprint for public relations. There are plenty of skaters in Madison and all over the world who would not want these close-minded people representing their views. Now that the park is finally done "One less person in MY way" seems to be their motto. That's crazy because I'm fine with taking turns, and sharing. It's something I learned early on in MADISON PUBLIC SCHOOLS (!) and carry with me wherever I travel. Maybe Leotha Stanley could come and sing to the skaters about sharing and love like he did for us in first grade.

Among the large donors for the Madison park were supposed bicycle-friendly sources such as the Willy Street Co-op. A large \$10,000 donation was given by the Tony Hawk Foundation. A quick internet search showed me that THF includes legendary BMXer Mat Hoffman as a member of the benefit committee for his yearly skate/BMX events. Tony Hawk also profits immensely from his own line of skatepark ready BMX bikes bearing his name in bold letters on the bikes' bottom tubes. They are sold to children in Madison and all over the country in large stores such as Walmart and Toys R Us. To sell a kid a bike and then not let them into a skatepark you helped build is absurd and un-ethical. To sell a kid a bike with pegs and then tell them grinding in a skatepark you built is prohibited and malicious behavior is conflicting. Should we just send the loitering and trespassing tickets those kids receive because they have nowhere to legally express themselves straight to Toys R Us corporate headquarters then? Hillyard skatepark, one of the parks where I live (Spokane, WA) was the recipient of a 2003 Tony Hawk Foundation grant and to this day is a place that bikers, skaters, scooters, unicycles, wheelchairs, roller derby girls etc. share and shred. When I look at Madison now I see that unaffordable "exclusive" high rise "luxury" apartments replace the diverse old houses and buildings that once gave the awesome city its character. Changes are inevitable and growth can be good but don't let your skatepark be a microcosm of an exclusionary line of thinking. That's not the Madison I remember. Let people share what few FREE public spaces we have left in the world, before they're all gone and privatized. Let people deal with sharing and working out their differences. I thought skateboarders prided themselves on being able to adapt to situations with an open

mind? Adversity should never turn the oppressed into the oppressor. Did they just all get old and bitter and become the security guards they used to loathe? It's not the Berrics after all, it's a public park.

Plastic pedals/pegs, which work better on a marble ledge, would cause no more damage than a skateboard's aluminum trucks would.
