Review of National Register of Historic Places Nomination for the Gay Building - 14-16 N Carroll Street (District 4)

Bailey provided an overview of the National Register of Historic Places nomination for the Gay Building.

Kaliszewski said she was happy to see the nomination because the building was a good representation of local history, particularly with its influence on height restrictions in Madison.

Morrison agreed that the context with tall buildings and the fight of zoning on a basic level was interesting. He said that for the applicable National Register criteria, criteria A is checked because of zoning and height, and he asked if it was possible to add criteria C as well because the building exhibits the type of architecture and style of that period.

Ely-Ledesma said that she appreciated the very thorough nomination.
