Members of the Madison Food Policy Council, below are the recommendations for 2023 SEED Grants funding. Six proposals were ultimately recommended for funding via a thorough deliberation process that included 3-member review teams to score and evaluate proposals and a group discussion on recommendation strategies. Please note that in total -- 27 applications were submitted, requesting \$232,629.65 in total funding and that the SEED Grants funding authority for 2023 is \$50,000.

"Expanded Curbside Groceries for Madison Families", The River Food Pantry, Inc.

- Up to \$9,433 to fund:
 - Additional Food/Meals Inventory

"Provision of Halal Meats for Food Insecure Muslim Immigrants", Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish (DBA Catholic Multicultural Center)

- Up to \$6,111 to fund:
 - Halal Meat
 - Translation & Advertising
 - Printing & Office

"Troy Farm Partnership Infrastructure", Rooted WI, Inc.

- Up to \$9,433 to fund:
 - Welded fence gate
 - Cold storage shelving
 - Heater installation (Hooper Service)
 - Farm Partner Liaison crew member

"Summer Meals for Elver Park and Theresa Terrace Neighborhood Center Youth", Wisconsin Youth Company, Inc. (DBA Elver Park Neighborhood Center)

- Up to \$9,196 to fund:
 - Part-Time LTE Position
 - One meal/day and one snack/day for 70 children

"Nutritious Food For All", Vera Court Neighborhood Center, Inc.

- Up to \$9,433 to fund:
 - o Fresh Produce Stand
 - Community Meals Food Costs

- Up to \$6,392 to fund:
