About the Commission

The Affirmative Action Commission is made up of Madison residents who care about civil rights and equal opportunities. The Commission:

- Reviews and helps improve the City's Affirmative Action Plan.
- Makes recommendations to the Mayor and Common Council.
- Shares information with the community about their rights to fair employment and contracting practices.
- Suggests and reviews rules related to affirmative action.
- Members of the commission may also choose to serve on the Affirmative Action Appeals Committee.
 - The subcommittee holds hearings when a contractor has yet to come into compliance with the City's Affirmative Action rules (General Ordinance 39.02 (9)(g)).
