RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

27. Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Seminole Storm Sewer Reroute, Contract No. 6057. (10th AD)

The project will reroute stormwater that travels east behind the University of Wisconsin Arboretum, through Greene Prairie. The stormwater will be redirected into Dunn's Marsh following a treatment in a new, upstream 0.46-acre stormwater settling pond. The pond will be constructed to reduce the particulate solids loading by 47.9%. The storm pipe relocation and pond construction will reduce undesirable sediment deposition to both Dunn's Marsh and Greene Prairie and reduce the erosive velocities and peak flows to downstream waterways. Estimated cost is \$200, 000.00. Report by City Engineering.
