6. Commercial, Kedzie, Pawling, Schofield, 8th Street Reconstruction

This project will disturb more than an acre, which shall require a Notice of Intent permit from the DNR and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management permit from City Engineering. (Jim Wolfe, City Engineering)

25. East Towne/Starkweather Greenway

This project will disturb more than an acre, which shall require a Notice of Intent permit from the DNR and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management permit from City Engineering. The project also involves work in a water of the U.S. and wetland impacts; the pertinent DNR permits have been applied for and the 30-day public notice has been recently published in the Wisconsin State Journal. 28. Bioretention at Bernie's Beach

This project will disturb more than 4,000 square feet, which will require an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management permit from City Engineering. (Greg Fries, City Engineering)
