Board of Health for Madison and Dane County To Receive Funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services

Public Health—Madison and Dane County has received a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Bureau of Environmental & Occupational Health to assess whether private wells continue to be impacted by the heavy rain and flooding in June 2008. The PHMDC laboratory will assess the long-term impact of flooding on bacterial water quality in private wells in vulnerable Dane County locations. PHMDC sanitarians will make on-site visits at properties to areas with contaminated wells to assess the needs and verify that corrective action has been taken.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County, authorizes the Director to sign an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Bureau of Environmental & Occupational Health for a grant of \$44,000 to assess the impact of the flooding in 2008 on bacterial water quality in private wells in Dane County.
