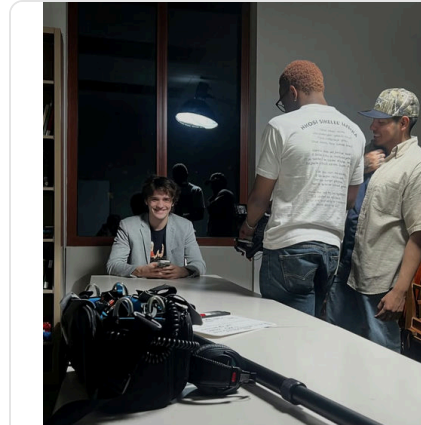

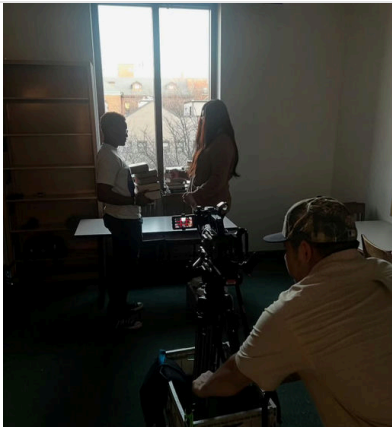

☰ Conceptual Approach

The Midwest is home to a large community of talented performers. While I have been blessed and fortunate enough to attract mentors who have opened the doors for me, not many others are as fortunate. Camp Lonestar was created as a unique opportunity to facilitate a space for local young artists to perform and network with other professionals to showcase what Madison and the greater Midwest have to offer.

Camp Lonestar is meant to be a reframing and reclamation of western iconography. Historically speaking, African Americans are underrepresented in Western media, although they make up 25% of all cowboys. Indigenous Americans are poorly represented and not nearly credited enough for their influence on land knowledge and trading.

Camp Lonestar was created to celebrate and uplift the work of artists of all walks of life, with a particular focus on artists of color. In trying times where various institutions are working against the principles of inclusion, it is our job to honor ourselves and our works as well as what brings us together as a community. In that way, we may have the fortitude to enter the world with a newfound sense of our star power.

Project Description (400 words or less)

Camp Lonestar is a one-day indoor music festival that showcases live musical and dance performances with a captivating camp/western theme. It creates a rich world that reflects a desire to connect and celebrate a diverse group of artists and tackle the wild world of the arts business.

This event will be held at the Bur Oak event venue, 2262 Winnebago St, Madison, WI 53704. The Bur Oak, nestled in the heart of the Atwood neighborhood, is a perfect venue for this event. Exposed Barrel roof, brick walls, and hand-laid tiles give a rustic, aged, and almost saloon feel, further affirming and preserving the history of this century-old building. In an event made to thematically be an ode to the past, while stirring up excitement for the future, we welcome audiences to enjoy the amenities and beautiful features that this venue and neighborhood have to offer.

The festival will be held on August 10th, beginning at 7 pm and ending at midnight.

Featured at this camp would be a collective of 8-12 performers ranging from indie rockers, rappers, to R&B singers, dancers, and spoken word poets.

Slated to perform at this event would be returning performers including Earth2Bam(Alternaive RNB), Jonah Kuya (Classical guitar and vocalist), Fa!son (rap), Femi Ishola (Rap), Thee Valley (Indie Rock Cover Band) as well as new additions Jason Jai (Rap) and DJ EVE (Afrobeats, Rnb, Rap, Reggeaton DJ), All performers would be from Madison or Chicago showcasing talent from here in the state and the greater midwest.

Key highlights of the event would include 5 hours of non-stop music, a state-of-the-art sound system with theatre lights, catered food from an indigenous owned and operated "Frybread Shack," and a raffle for custom Camp Lone Star Art and Apparel.
