Chris, Alder Rummel, et al.,

Below is the MNA Board resolution on the Working Draft Brewery for an outdoor patio.

Note that it is similar to the staff recommendations except that a reduce number of permitted users of the patio for the first six months was lowered to 30, and the increase to 40 after six months was conditioned on approval by the alder. This is intended to introduce a graduated use of this 'rear yard patio' as a partial measure for nearby residents to adjust to the new sounds this will engender. It is anticipated that problems with sound may not be addressed until after there is a problem, as has often been the case with new uses in existing neighborhood spaces.

The plan/design that the board reviewed had few elements that would buffer sound, thus the last statement. The proponents were encouraged to install sound buffering devices such as other owners of outdoor drinking establishments. Some MNA P&D Committee as well as board comments didn't think that reliance on an existing hedgerow would suffice to buffer sound. The MNA resolution was prior to the neighborhood meeting with nearby residents called by Alder Rummel.
