RFSP is in the beginning phase of community engagement process, launching projects and looking for community partnerships to expand our work and connections. Some updates:

- · Consumer Survey: Nearing completion of survey creation
- Podcast: Recording and editing of podcast episodes underway

- Data Analysis: Utilizing 2024 Ag Census data to inform the food action plan, in addition to our ongoing literature review process and SWOT analysis
- Commercial Food Space Roundtable: Planning and organizing a roundtable discussion between landlords and food business renters
- Agricultural Producer Survey: Drafting and launching a general survey to gather insights from farmers.
- Network Mapping: Created an on-going tool to map out stakeholders in our local food system
- Timeline and Extension: Exploring a no-cost extension with USDA to allow for additional time to complete the project. While aiming for completion in 2025, the primary objective is to achieve meaningful progress and meet project goals by Spring of 26'
