## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COMMISSION



Public Comments are now being considered on the City's Substantial Amendment to the Consolidated Plan 2008 Action Plan that includes the new Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP). The Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program is part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. HPRP are federal funds which can be used to provide financial assistance, housing relocation and housing stabilization services to persons who are homeless or who are at risk of homelessness. This Amendment is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as a condition for receiving HPRP funds. Once the City receives approval from HUD, the City intends to contract for services with not for profit agency(s) that serve the target population.
