30 on the square will be in use all day, the Children's museum is still using Rotary Plaza, WE will be using the North and South Hamilton capitol walkways.

Update : Blooming Grove Dean House is on the list

There will be four pianos on sidewalks- these are not listed in the program, and not 100% confirmed- One will be in front of Graze, 1 S Pinckney S, one in front of Square Wine company, 5 North Pinckney, one across the sidewalk near pedestrian park bench, but not obstructing traffic, in front of Broach's, 7 west Main and one on State Street, location to be determined.

I think all of the parking lots are privately owned, so I didn't list them. I probably overlooked a few locales listed as "private residences" and "other," but this is a good start. There are numerous venues that registered, but did not complete matchmaking. Some of those may yet have performances, but are not Listed here. There are a couple of neighborhood parks that may likewise have un-scheduled performances, and We are not discouraging spontaneous acts of music-making.
