RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

19. Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Contract No. 6231, Professional Drilling Services associated with the Installation of a Groundwater Monitoring (Sentry) Well - Unit Well #29 / Sycamore Landfill. (17th AD)

Estimated cost of this project is \$45,000 which is to be split evenly between the Water Utility and the Engineering Division. A recent groundwater modeling study has indicated that the Sycamore Landfill should have no impact on the water at Unit Well #29 (831 N. Thompson Dr.) when pumped at an average annual rate of 1100 GPM. To insure that landfill contaminants are not migrating toward the Unit Well, it was recommended that a monitoring well be installed between the Sycamore Landfill and Unit Well #29. This monitoring well, which is to be sampled and analyzed on a routine basis, will act as a Sentry System. The drilling of this well will also provide detailed subsurface information necessary in characterizing the geologic formations occurring both locally and regionally (aquifers and aquitards, etc.) Report by Water Utility and Engineering.

20. 11833 Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for "Arboretum Storm / Pond #3 Restoration, Phase 1". (14th AD)

Estimated cost of this project is \$48,000. This project involves clearing approximately 2.17 acres in the vicinity of Arboretum Pond #3 to facilitate repairs of the existing drainage way and prepare the site for future survey and site work. The existing drainage way that enters from the south into the area proposed for clearing is eroding just past the existing riprap and gabion area. This needs to be repaired to reduce erosion until a final storm water plan can be developed for the area. It is anticipated that a Phase 2 project for this area will incorporate the City's drainage way, the adjacent detention ponds and Arboretum Pond #3 into one overall design for storm water management improvements.
