**SUMMARY:**

At its meeting of October 4, 2017, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of demolition of the existing building, construction of a surface parking lot to serve the second phase of the Exact Sciences Clinical Laboratory and additional interior build-out of the existing office building at 601 Rayovac Drive in UDD No. 2 located at 630 Forward Drive. Appearing on behalf of the project were Jody Shaw, Suzanne Vincent and Justin Zampardi, representing Exact Sciences.

The island beds need to be 75% vegetative cover by code, with no stone mulch; it must be shredded bark mulch.
