I oppose ALRC item 87784 - to construct a 6'6" fence at Breese to enclose the area outside gate 1, the sidewalk, and a parking/traffic lane on Paterson St. on "concert/event days" - This would be every weekend until November.

Big Top was selected to manage games at this historic landmark, not run a patio bar and obstruct the pedestrian view of the stadium at the front gate.

The intersection at Paterson is home to a new center street BRT station and indeed is very busy. During the last two years of construction of Bakers Place, residents and visitors from Tenney and Wilmar Neighborhoods have still been able to cross at this crosswalk despite Paterson Street being closed. With Paterson about to reopen, there will be new and more hectic motor vehicle traffic which should be seriously considered. This proposed temporary fence would not offer real safety for those inside the fence.

If there is a plan to close Paterson street for every event, this has not been presented to the public.

Do not allow this fence and sidewalk bar that would negatively impact the neighborhood's quality of life in multiple ways.
