## Board of Health for Madison and Dane County Tobacco Control and Prevention

## Resolution # 2008-05

Public Health—Madison and Dane County has received a new grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services on behalf of Tobacco Free Dane County for \$12,868 for tobacco control funding. The Tobacco Free Dane County Coalition works to reduce tobacco-related disease and death by preventing the initiation of tobacco use among youth, promoting quitting among young people and adults, eliminating exposure to secondhand smoke, and identifying and eliminating tobacco related health disparities. Funding from this grant will be used to address the burden of tobacco use and exposure in Wisconsin by protecting youth and adults from secondhand smoke.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County is authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services in the amount of \$12,868, for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, for tobacco control services, and the Director is authorized to execute the contract.
