## Madison Public Library Board welcomes Kathleen Woit

Kathleen Woit will address the Madison Public Library Board regarding the National Endowment for the Humanities grant that the Madison Community Foundation has secured for providing cultural programming for all Dane County Libraries.

Monroe Street Branch site of MGE charging station for electronic vehicles.

MG&E will be installing nine electronic vehicle charging stations at five locations in Madison. One of those is the parking lot next to the Monroe Street Branch. The Library Board is asked to authorize the Execution of Agreement with MG&E re the charging station at Monroe Street. (ID#22598 and ID#23072, in your packet.)

## Temporary Quarters - Phase 2.

The Library Board needs to authorize the execution of a lease at 2109 South Stoughton Road for the temporary relocation of the City of Madison's Central Public Library collections. This 11,000 square feet of space will house Central collections and some staff until the new Central is finished. This is the State Department of Public Instruction site, and since DPI is on the South Central Library System delivery, the collections at this site will be available, via delivery, for anyone who requests them. Madison Central Friends group donates to Central Library campaign

The Friends of Madison Public Library – Central have committed to giving \$100,000 to the Central Library campaign over 5 years. The Friends already have over \$80,000 and expect to raise the rest over the 5 years.
