## Rules Governing BCC's

 MGO Chapter 33: Establishes and Regulates BCC's, including subcommittees

- BPC Rules of Procedure and Basic Policies
  - Required by MGO 33.05(05), updated/approved by BPC in July 2020
  - Further clarifies roles and expectations for each body

Long-Range Planning	future direction of the entire Parks System

#### General Duties of the Subcommittee:

- Advise BPC regarding the following as it relates to the Golf Program:
  - Policies
  - Rate structure
  - Rules and regulations
  - Capital improvements
  - User complaints
  - Operations
  - The selection of golf pros
- The Golf Supervisor shall serve as Secretary of the subcommittee.

#### Golf Subcommittee Members

- Composed of one Park Commissioner
- President or designee representing the following:
  - Odana Golf Association
  - Yahara Golf Association
  - Madison Area Retiree Association
  - Women's Municipal Golf Association
  - Two at-large members
    - Appointed by the President of the Park Commission.
- All must be City of Madison Residents

#### Recommendations from TFOGS

- Task Force on Government Structure (TFOGS)
  - Issued Final report in 2019
  - Recommendations for effective government and accountability (among others):
    - Eliminate or combine BCCs that are redundant or have outlived their purpose
    - Implement new procedures, policies, and resources to make it easier for residents to provide input to BCC's.
- Board of Park Commissioners currently evaluating subcommittee structure
  - Expected to discuss in early 2023
