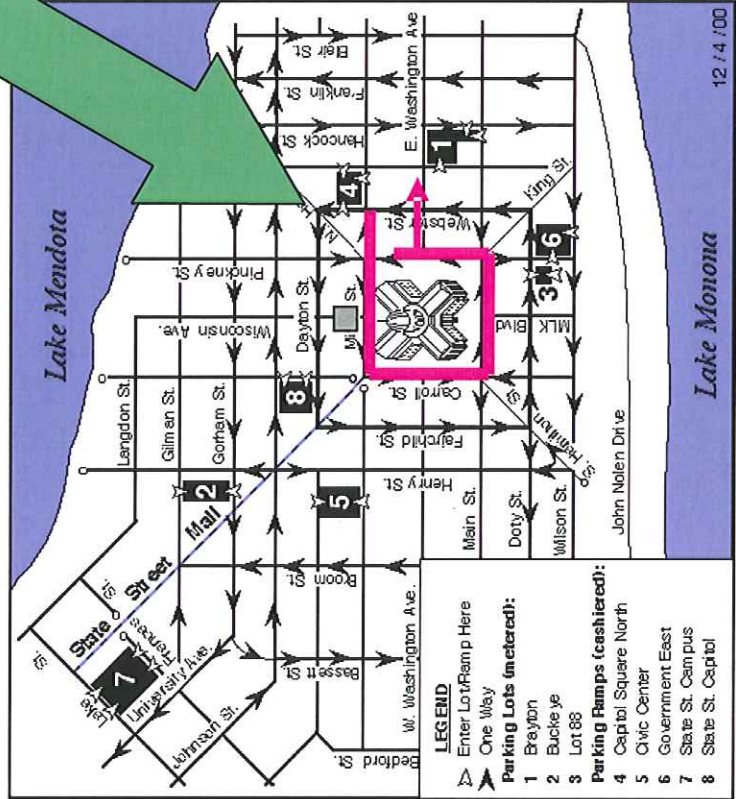
Parade Route Information

- Parade steps off from the intersection of N. Pinckney and E. Mifflin St. (Headquarters location).
