Personnel:

- 40 recruits passed Chief's interview process going on to PAT.
  - PAT practices last week.
  - PAT following week.
- AE process – 10 candidates forwarded to the PFC for approval. \$ will be promoted shortly with the remainder the beginning of 2019.

Support Service:

- Station #14 –CMU Block walls going up. On schedule. \$ fold doors on front of building passed through PW. No increase in overall budget at this time.
- Station 10 – window replacement, asbestos removal and bathroom remodeling.
- New Medic 7 and 8 in service.

Training:

- 10 paramedic students – Presently in ride along phase, waiting on results from national registry. 8 have passed, 2 still testing.
